Cascade Clamps - Cascade Manufacturing Company was founded in Portland, Oregon in the year 1943. They began as a small machine shop initially hiring 4 individuals. Sales for their first year of operation totaled \$60,000. The first recorded sales revenues involved the assembly and machining of stainless-steel valves, pipe fittings and other components. Within five years of operation, the company had stretched to 40 staff and their annual sales volume had increased to 330 thousand dollars. These days, Cascade is amongst the top worldwide manufacturers within the material handling trade.

Design and production of the company's very first hydraulic cylinder allowed this new company to aggressively pursue better business opportunities. All through the last 60 years, the business of material handling has grown into a very advanced area with Cascade proudly playing a part in its progress. Cascade at the moment continues to develop as the best provider of lift truck accessories and different related items. The business feels confident in their capability in order to continue to lead the way within the business by understanding client's needs in the future and remaining competitive in the global market.

In the nineteen fifties, Cascade began designing, making and selling hydraulic accessories. Manufacturing was finished in 1956 on a brand new office to house all of the office and plant operations in Portland, Oregon at the company's present headquarters. Following 15 years of business, total workers reached one hundred eighty workers and sales had reached almost 2.3 million dollars.

In the year 1959 in Springfield, Eugene the next manufacturing facility was built. The year 1960 marked Cascade's preliminary move into the international world of the material handling industry when the business established interest in the Netherlands, England, and Australia.

The business altered its name to Cascade Corporation in the year 1964. In 1965, Cascade went public with an initial offering of two hundred thousand shares of common stock. The company has expanded its production facilities within the United States with locations in Portland, Oregon, Springfield, Eugene, and Warner Robins, Georgia. Cascade products are made internationally due to lots of subsidiary operations. In the year 1944, a new plant was completed in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European headquarters. This facility is designed to be the essential customer support centre.

Continuing to grow, Cascade expanded their product offering further in the year 1996 and the year 1997 with the impressive acquisition of five firms, together with the global leader in blades, the Kenhar Corporation.
